### **Players Code of Conduct**



- Understand the laws of the game and play by them.
- Be punctual and prepared for all training sessions and games. (Dressed appropriately with shin guards, cleats, home/away jerseys, water/sports drink.)
- Cooperate and be respectful to all coaches, teammates, opponents, and match Officials.
- Support your teammates, Club members, teams and coaches.
- Be gracious in victory and dignified in defeat.
- Do not talk to fans during matches.
- Do not argue with officials.
- Talk to opposing players should be limited to congratulations and offers of assistance.
- Do not use abusive or profane language.
- Fighting or physical violence will result in a mandatory suspensions; fighting after a suspension may result in dismissal from the Club.
- No consumption of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.

The Hoosier FC\* Board of Directors and Director of Coaching will review the status of any player who is ejected from two games in a 12 month period or accumulates excessive cautions.

The Hoosier FC Board of Directors and Director of Coaching can suspend or expel any player for acting in a manner not deemed fit by the Club\*. If the player is suspended or expelled from the Club, player card will be pulled and no refund will be given for a suspended or expelled player.

## **HOOSIER FUTBOL CLUB, INC. Parents Code of Conduct**



- Provide only positive support during games.
- Refrain from attempting to coach your child from the sidelines.
- Do not argue with officials.
- Do not argue with opposing fans.
- Do not criticize your child's teammates or coaches in the presence of your child or his/her teammates.
- Do not use abusive or profane language.
- Do not criticize opponents in the presence of them or their fans.
- Do not talk to players or coaches for either team during matches, except to offer support, congratulations or assistance.
- Be gracious in victory and dignified in defeat.

Parents will not knowingly participate in or knowingly permit violation or circumvention of Hoosier FC, IYSA, or USYSA rules.

Fighting, verbal and/or written threats, or physical violence will result in automatic suspension from the Club\* premises and activities. Ejection of a parent during a match including stepparents or legal guardian for inappropriate behavior will include a written warning and review of the parents Code of Conduct. A second incident of ejection will result in suspension from Club premises and activities. Any incident involving a Hoosier FC\* parent including stepparents or legal guardian who is ejected from a soccer match must be documented by the team manager within 48 hours of the incident. The documentation will be submitted to the Hoosier FC Board of Directors for review and action. The Hoosier FC Board of Directors can suspend or expel any parent, stepparent or legal guardian for acting in a manner not deemed fit by the Club. Repeat violations will result in expulsion from the Club. No refunds will be given.

If you have a problem with a member of Hoosier FC's coaching staff, please give a 48-hour cooling off period before contacting the individual concerned.
